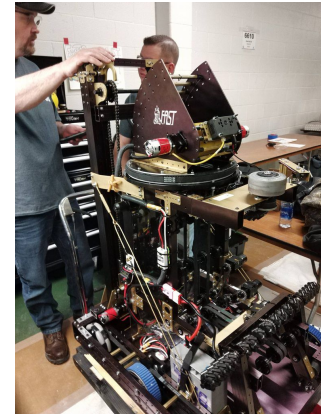

School Attendance

Students who accumulate 9 or more absences in one or more of their classes per semester may lose credit. For students that miss class for medical reasons, documentation will need to be provided to the attendance office to excuse the absence.

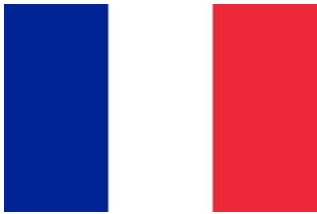
