The Fowlerville School District is located in the western portion of Livingston County. It is a rural setting with beautiful rolling country side with a combination of woods and farm land. Livingston County and has been one of the fastest growing counties in Michigan, however, residential growth has slowed significantly in the Fowlerville School District the past few years. Fowlerville has become attractive for commercial and industrial development with easy access to I-96 and a commutable distance to Lansing, Ann Arbor and Detroit.

The school district covers 116 square miles with a population of 15,000. All the district facilities are located on one campus with convenient access to one another. On a typical day, the transportation department will transport 60% of the student population, and travel over 2,400 miles.

The 2010 Census data shows Fowlerville having 12.97% of residents in poverty level while the State has 14.85% in poverty. The Fowlerville Community has 15.46% of residents who have a Bachelor's Degree compared to the national average of 17.6%. Only 9.56% of Residents have a Masters degree or higher, which also falls below the National Average of 10.3% These percentages tell us that we will have to continuously provide communications to students to want to achieve and obtain higher degrees.

The total number of K-12 Students has averaged 2,970 the past three years. with 54% male population to a 46% female population. 95% of students are white with 5% of students who are Hispanic, Asian, Black. The staff has been stable for the past three years, with the 2012-13 school year being the first year with more than three teacher hiring's, and new principals in four of the five buildings!

In this Study, O'Connor and colleagues (2005) investigated the effects of Tier 2 and Tier 3 reading interventions on a variety of reading skills. When compared with an historical contrast group, students who had received tiered instruction performed higher on all reading measures. All students showed large gains on reading measures, especially those exposed to 30 weeks of intervention. They also found that approximately a third of the exiting students failed to "thrive" in the general education class and needed more supplemental instruction at later points in time.

According to the IES article, "Use of the 6+1 Trait Writing Model caused a statistically significant difference in three writing traits – Organization, Voice, and Word Choice...The mean outcome score of students in the treatment condition was higher than that of students in the control condition for the other three traits- ideas, sentence fluency, and conventions." [p. 57] According to our needs assessment, a majority of students were not proficient in ideas, conventions, sentence fluency, and word choice.

Also, our data from this year told us students need special focus in genre studies, writer's purpose, and writing process. According to the NREL article, "The 6+1 Writing model incorporates writing process as an integral component of a recursive set of activities that develop the seven traits that characterize quality writing. " [p.7] According to the article by Steven Graham, "It All Starts Here, "...students should be given every chance of success, including intensive intervention for students who are not meeting grade level expectations." (p. 8) Hisresearch shows that students who do not have foundational skills need to revisit skills missed in younger years. The strategy of Writer's Workshop inherently provides students with explicit instruction in writing skills, processes, and strategies as well as ample time and opportunity

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to practice and apply what they learn. This will also help our non-proficient students to reach our goal of 7% annual improvement as measured by the 4th and 7th grade Writing MEAP.

This paper describes why learning teams are the best professional development method for improving assessment skills. It includes an outline of specific steps to setting up and conducting learning teams with the Institute's materials.

Methodology: Randomized controlled study A national panel of literacy experts selected the Reading Apprenticeship Academic Literacy course as one of only two ninthgrade reading interventions to be evaluated in a rigorous national study funded by the U.S. Department of Education. Students and their teachers in 34 schools nationwide participated in this randomized controlled study, conducted by independent research agencies MDRC and AIR, to measure course implementation and student outcomes, including reading comprehension, persistence in school, course-taking patterns, and performance on high-stakes tests.
