Community: Fowlerville High School is located within the village of Fowlerville in western Livingston County. Fowlerville is twenty-five miles east of Lansing, Michigan and three miles north of I-96. The total Fowlerville school district is 120 square miles. The district includes the townships of Iosco, Handy, Conway, and Cohoctah as well as small parts of several other townships. It also includes the village of Fowlerville. Once a predominantly agricultural community, Fowlerville is now a bedroom community for workers in both the Detroit metropolitan area, as well as the Lansing area.

School: Public; 750 students in Grades 9-12; 6 class periods of 57 minutes each - 5 days per week - 2 semesters per school year. Staff to Student ratio is 18:1 with a staff of 46 highly qualified professionals, with an average of 16 years teaching experience.

Grades are weighted for AP courses, but not for courses with honors designation. All courses from grades 9 - 12 are calculated into GPA on a semester basis. Class rank is calculated at the end of each semester while final class rank is based on the end of the seventh semester of a student's high school career. The following weighted grades system will be used for these calculations: A = 4.5; A- = 4.17; B+ = 3.83; B = 3.5; B- = 3.17; C+ = 2.83; C = 2.50; C- = 2.17; D+ = 1.83; D = 1.50; D- = 1.17; E = .50.

Advanced Placement Courses Offered 2025 - 2026: AP Art Design Studio 2D, AP Drawing, AP Biology, AP Calculus, AP Chemistry, AP Literature, AP Language, AP Physics, and AP US History. Students are able to enroll in all AP online courses. 20 total AP courses for 25-26 academic year.

Honors/College Prep Courses Offered 2025 - 2026: Honors Sophomore Literature and Composition, CP Algebra II, CP Chemistry, CP ELA, and CP Math & Trig, CP German and CP Spanish.
