The Odysseyware lesson design fosters ongoing collaboration between learners and teachers, enabling students to progress and practice at their own pace and receive support and guided instruction as needed. Space is limited; please turn in this form along withthe fee as soon as possible. See your counselor if you're unsure which class(es) you need.
Credit Recovery Rules and procedures:  Students must attend first open lab time before starting a course to understand rules and procedures of FHS Credit Recovery Program.  Students are not required to attend in person lab times, they must work from home. If a student falls behind, the parent/guardian(s) will be contacted. Failure to make progress could result in removal from the program. No refunds will be given.  There will no longer be pre-testing.  Students taking an English course must write essays. These will be scored by the Writer ScoringMatrix for word count, grade level, readability, and topic agreement.  Students are expected to finish their course within one semester. Students who fail to meet the semester deadline will be dropped from the course and will not receive credit.  Credit Recovery Students are enrolled in 1 course at a time. Students wishing to enroll in an additional course may not do so until all previous courses are completed successfully.
