Community: Fowlerville High School is located within the village of Fowlerville in western Livingston County. Fowlerville is twenty-five miles east of Lansing, Michigan and three miles north of I-96. It also includes the village of Fowlerville. Once a predominantly agricultural community, Fowlerville is now a bedroom community for workers in both the Detroit metropolitan area, as well as the Lansing area.
