**Community:** Fowlerville High School is located within the village of Fowlerville in western Livingston County. Fowlerville is twenty-five miles east of Lansing, Michigan and three miles north of I-96. The total Fowlerville school district is 120 square miles. The district includes the townships of Iosco, Handy, Conway, and Cohoctah as well as small parts of several other townships. It also includes the village of Fowlerville. Once a predominantly agricultural community, Fowlerville is now a bedroom community for workers in both the Detroit metropolitan area, as well as the Lansing area.

**School:** Public; 870 students in Grades 9-12; 3 class periods block schedule (M/W, T/TH) 2 hours each – 4 days per week – 2 semesters per school year. Average class size is 29 students and a staff of 47 professionals of which over 66% have Master’s Degree or beyond.

Class rank is calculated at the end of each semester while final class rank is based on the end of the seventh semester of a student’s high school career. The following weighted grades system will be used for these calculations: A = 4.5; A- = 4.17; B+ = 3.83; B = 3.5; B- = 3.17; C+ = 2.83; C = 2.50; C- = 2.17; D+ = 1.83; D = 1.50; D- = 1.17; E = .50.
